This is a word game called a BACKRONYM. Now you probably know quite a lot of ACRONYMS. That's when you take a phrase and use the first letter of each word to make it shorter. So **BTW** is an acronym for **By The Way and IDK** for **I Don't Know**. Why not make a list of all the acronyms you can think of?

A backronym is like the opposite of an acronym – you start with the shorter word and make it into a longer sentence.

Here's a backronym Magpie has done. Can you work out the original word? Mysterious Alligators Gleefully Put Ice Everywhere!

And what about this one?

Unusually Rotten Seaweed Understands Lonely Alpaca.

Now it's your turn to make a backronym. You could start by making a different one for MAGPIE. Write the letters down, one on each line, and then make a word starting with each letter. I bet you've got lots of ideas!
